A DECADE FOR **BUILDING OUR INFRASTRUCTURE**

- Obtain funding for the Northern Port Access Route.
- Promote a new train station for Drogheda's northside.
- Enhance and improve our public transport services with the new D4 & D5 services.
- Complete the extension and refurbishment of St. Mary's and Boyne View House on the Dublin Road.
- Develop capacity at Drogheda Port and support the redevelopment of the town quays space.
- Build the new stadium for Drogheda United FC and our new municipal playing pitches in the northern environs.

A DECADE FOR GAINING OUR CITY STATUS

- Advance my legislation to restore power to Drogheda Borough Council.
- Secure city designation and promote greater co-operation between Louth & Meath.

A DECADE OF **CREATING NEW EDUCATIONAL FACILITIES**

- Obtain more school places and investment in and support for our local schools and staff.
- Develop a satellite campus of DkIT in Drogheda.
- Ensure that government builds the new Louth & Meath Education & Training Board HQ on the site I secured for the town, beside St Oliver's School.

A DECADE OF **GREENING THE ENVIRONMENT WE SHARE**

- Make Drogheda a 'green city'.
- Make Drogheda a pedestrian and cyclist friendly town with more cycleways and pedestrian facilities.
- Develop a playground and nature area on the northside of Drogheda.
- Secure 'Living City' status for Drogheda's historic core and complete the redevelopment and regeneration of the West Gate area.

A DECADE OF IMPROVING OUR QUALITY OF LIFE

- Attract meaningful IDA investment to the area (implementation of the Action Plan for Jobs I developed in 2015/16) so that we get more jobs in a high-quality environment.
- Provide a safer community with more Garda resources and a multi-agency response to drug crime and the social impact of problem drug use.
- Promote Drogheda as a 'Living Wage' city.
- Create and implement a plan to support our town centre as a prime retail destination.
- The Drogheda we love shone brightly during the times of the Fleadh. Let's harness the energy and goodwill created to establish Drogheda as the 'culture capital' of the North East, providing dedicated studio space for artists and attracting other artists and tourists to the area.
